Ngā whāinga | Purpose

To provide information regarding Te Koukou Transport Committee Workshop to be held 7 May 2024.

Horopaki | Context

- In 2016, Council formally adopted the recommendations of the “Northland Transport Collaboration Opportunities Business Case” resulting in the pooling of their transport resources into a Shared Services Business Unit (SSBU) which is known as the Northland Transportation Alliance (NTA).
- A review of how transportation services are being delivered in Northland has been undertaken, informed by:
 - Rational section 17a Review (April 2023)
 - Field Force Four Maintenance Contracts Review and subsequent Contract Rejuvenation process
 - Integral Group Review of Transportation Services (March 2024)
 - NTA Review Documents – Consolidated Staff Feedback dated 4 April 2024
- These reports and information on options for how transportation services could be delivered is being provided to inform workshop discussions with each Council over the coming weeks.
- The outcomes of these workshops will inform a decisions paper to Council.
