- 3. As a submitter and/or further submitter, you are invited to attend the hearing where the Hearing Commissioners will consider the submissions in support of/or opposing the Proposed District Plan Provisions.
- 4. A list of submissions being considered for Hearing 15D is provided in Table 1, attached to this Hearing Notice.

Procedure for Hearing of Submissions

5. This letter sets out matters relating to the hearing. Further detail is available in Panel Minute 1: <u>Procedures for Hearing of Submissions</u>.

Rezoning Criteria and Process

- 6. Submitters are encouraged to review the process and criteria to review <u>Final Panel Minute</u> <u>14</u>: Rezoning Criteria and Process, which sets out the following process for information/evidence exchange:
 - 16 weeks before hearing (earlier if possible) submitters file their evidence for their rezoning submission, addressing the criteria below as applicable and providing supporting section 32AA evaluation.
 - 12 weeks before hearing further submitters supporting or opposing the rezoning submission file their evidence.
 - 4 weeks before hearing reporting officers provide section 42A report for the rezoning sub-topic.
 - 2 weeks before hearing submitters can file rebuttal evidence.

Note that any submitters who do not wish to "opt in" may provide their evidence two weeks prior to the hearing. The Panel has strongly encouraged submitters with substantial or complex rezoning requests to engage in the Minute 14 process as amended as a means of having a more collaborative, and overall efficient, approach to having their requests considered.

- 7. Providers of expert evidence are referred to paragraphs 56 to 64, and 68 to 69 of Panel Minute 1: Procedures for Hearing of Submissions. The evidence should clearly outline any changes in Plan wording proposed (along with the rationale for these changes) together with an assessment pursuant to S32AA of the RMA.
- 8. When a submitter speaks to their submission only (i.e. is not giving expert evidence), this is considered **lay evidence**. Submitters can present written lay evidence on the day of the hearing and read it aloud. It is not required to be pre-circulated. However, it would be of benefit to the Hearing Panel and other parties if any lay evidence is pre-circulated and able to be read before the hearing. Submitters need to bring ten (10) copies of any written



material to the hearing and supply an electronic copy to the Hearings Administrator within two (2) working days of completing their presentation.

- 9. Where a submitter or their representative is unable to attend the hearing for a particular topic, and are not supplying expert evidence, they may choose to table written lay evidence in support of their submission. Submitters must provide any tabled evidence to the Hearings Administrator at least 5 working days prior to the hearing on the topic commencing.
- 10. All evidence is expected to be provided electronically. Evidence can be sent to the Hearings Administrator alicia-kate.taihia@fndc.govt.nz.
- 11. The Hearing Administrator will email the hearing parties to advise when new material is on the Council's website.
- 12. If you have any additional written material to present at the hearing, please bring ten (10) copies to the hearing and supply an electronic copy to the Hearings Administrator within two (2) working days of completing your presentation. The Hearing Commissioners have received a copy of all submissions. You do not need to provide additional copies.

Presentations at the hearing

- 13. If you wish to speak at the hearing, please email Alicia-Kate Taihia <u>alicia-kate.taihia@fndc.govt.nz</u> with your hearing timetable response by Monday 15 September 2025. Your email should be titled "Hearing 15D Timetable Response", and needs to provide the following information:
 - Your daytime phone number. Your submission number(s).
 - The name(s) of who will be speaking to your submission (including any expert witnesses). An indication of how much time yourself and each of your representatives require to speak. Due to pre-circulation of evidence, the Commissioners expect each expert witness to require no more than 15 minutes to present their evidence.
 - Whether you will attend the hearing in-person or are making a request to appear online using the "TEAMS" platform. If making a request to appear online, please include an outline of reasons for the request.
 - Whether you will do a digital presentation (e.g. PowerPoint).
 - Whether you intend to present evidence in sign language or Te Reo Māori (requiring an interpreter).

14. Please note the following:

- We do not automatically assign people with speaking slots. If you wish to be heard, you need to provide the above information by the specified date.
- Any submitter who has been allocated additional hearing time is required to advise the Hearings Advisor if the additional time is no longer necessary.
- The safety and wellbeing of our customers, team members and communities is important to us. If you are sick or have COVID-19 symptoms, please do not attend the hearing in-person. You will still be able to participate in the hearing online. If you are presenting, please advise the hearings administrator.



- 15. The Hearing Administrator will prepare an indicative hearing schedule and post it on the website one week (5 working days) prior to the hearing commencing. The Hearing Administrator will email all hearing parties a link to the schedule as soon as it is confirmed.
- 16. Any submitter wishing to speak to their submission using a power-point presentation is required to provide the power-point in an electronic format to the Hearings Administrator at least three (3) working days prior to their scheduled hearing time.
- 17. Council intends to make all information for the Hearings available via the Council's website https://pdp.fndc.govt.nz. However, hard copies of documents can be provided to submitters on request.
- 18. Video recordings of the hearing will be posted to the Council's website as soon as practical after each hearing session.
