

## Appendix 1.2 – New definitions recommended for the Interpretation chapter

Insert new definitions relating to the Coastal Environment topic as follows:

<p><b><u>Afforestation</u></b></p>	<p><u>(a) means planting and growing commercial forestry trees on land where there is no commercial forestry and where commercial forestry harvesting has not occurred within the last 5 years; but</u></p> <p><u>(b) does not include vegetation clearance from the land before planting</u></p>
<p><b><u>Commercial forestry</u></b></p>	<p><u>means exotic continuous-cover forestry or plantation forestry</u></p>
<p><b><u>Exotic continuous-cover forestry</u></b></p>	<p><u>(a) means a forest that is deliberately established for commercial purposes, being at least 1 ha of continuous forest cover of exotic forest species that has been planted and—</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(i) will not be harvested or replanted; or</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(ii) is intended to be used for low-intensity harvesting or replanted; and</u></p> <p><u>(b) includes all associated forestry infrastructure; but</u></p> <p><u>(c) does not include—</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(i) a shelter belt of forest species, where the tree crown cover has, or is likely to have, an average width of less than 30 m; or</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(ii) forest species in urban areas; or</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(iii) nurseries and seed orchards; or</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(iv) trees grown for fruit or nuts; or</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(v) long-term ecological restoration planting of indigenous forest species; or</u></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>(vi) willows and poplars space planted for soil conservation purposes.</u></p>
