I, Gareth Raymond Anthony Doull, wish to be a party to the following proceedings:

ENV-2026-AKL-000155 – Bellingham Quarries Limited v Far North District Council, an appeal concerning provisions of the Proposed Far North District Plan Decisions Version, including Mineral Extraction Zone rules MEZ-R4, MEZ-R5 and MEZ-R7.

Parts of the proceedings I am interested in

I am interested in:

- MEZ-R4 – Expansion of existing mineral extraction activity;
- MEZ-R5 – New mineral extraction activity;
- MEZ-R7 – Activities not otherwise provided for;
- the proposed deletion of the 10% increased-extraction cap and 10 metre boundary setback; and
- any consequential amendments within the scope of the appeal affecting those provisions.

My position

Suggested wording – edit if needed:

I oppose the relief sought by Bellingham Quarries Limited to the extent that it would reduce the activity status, safeguards, setbacks, limits, assessment scope, or Council discretion applying to expansion of existing mineral extraction, new mineral extraction, or other activities within the Mineral Extraction Zone. I support retention of the Decisions Version provisions, or alternative wording within the scope of the appeal that retains appropriate safeguards and the ability to assess and manage significant adverse effects.

Reasons

Use only the reasons that genuinely apply to you and delete the rest:

- I live/own land close to Puketona Quarry and may experience site-specific effects from quarry expansion.
- More permissive activity status could reduce Council's ability to decline consent or fully assess site-specific effects.
- Removal of the 10% extraction cap and 10 m setback could increase the scale or proximity of quarrying effects.
- My concerns include noise, dust, vibration, traffic, water quality, wetlands/catchment effects, biodiversity, rural/residential amenity, cultural values and/or archaeology.
 - Our home has, for some years, had ongoing issues with the interior plaster over the concrete block walls cracking and falling off walls. The Tradesman undertaking recent repairs suggested this is due to ground vibration and has seen similar plaster failures in properties in the vicinity of quarries and sources of vibration before – despite apparent good quality workmanship.
- Ventia NZ Operations Limited operates Puketona Quarry and has joined this appeal, creating a direct practical connection between the appeal and Puketona.
