Got rubbish and recyclables?

The Far North District Council provides an extensive network of refuse transfer stations and community recycling centres. All sites will be closed on Christmas Day and New Year's Day, but will open as usual on other days. Go to www.fndc.govt.nz for details of opening hours which vary.

What can I recycle for free?

- Glass bottles and jars
- Tin and aluminium cans
- Plastic bottles and packaging with a ♻️, ♻️ or number ♻️ recycling symbol. Please rinse containers.
- Cardboard and paper
- Waste oil and batteries
- Whiteware and scrap metal (at selected refuse transfer stations)

Refuse Transfer Stations

Class 1 facilities

Kaikohe, Kaitiāia, Taipā, Waipapa, Whangae, Whitehills

- Bagged and bulk rubbish accepted
- Household recyclables accepted
- Most sites accept batteries, hazardous waste, tyres, oil, green waste and scrap metal

Mon-Fri: 7:30am-5pm
Sat & Sun: 9am-5pm

Class 2 facilities

Ahipara, Houhora, Ōpononi, Russell, Whatuwhiwhi

- Bagged and bulk rubbish accepted
- Household recyclables accepted
- Most sites accept batteries, hazardous waste, tyres, oil, green waste and scrap metal

Mon, Wed, Fri: 7:30am-1pm
Sat & Sun: 9am-1pm

Additional hours for 20 Dec to 13 Feb
Tue & Thu: 7:30am-1pm

Class 3 facilities

Awanui, Herekino, Kohukohu, Panguru, Te Kao

- Materials accepted are as above (class 2 facilities)
- Exception - bulk rubbish is NOT accepted

Awanui, Herekino, Kohukohu, Panguru, Te Kao:
Open three days a week, times vary.

Community recycling stations

- Rubbish not accepted
