Lawn Cemetery	All memorials must face the front and be 150mm (or more) in from the front and back edge of the concrete berm
Base	1000mm wide x 500mm deep x 150mm high. Flower holder(s) optional, must be recessed into or attached to top of base
Upright headstone	1000mm wide x 1500mm high x 250mm deep
Total Maximum height	1500mm

Ash Berm - cremation	All memorials must face the front and be 150mm (or more) in from the front and back edge of the concrete berm
Base	850mm wide x 400mm deep x 100mm high. Flower holder(s) optional, must be recessed into or attached to top of base
Recumbent Desk	(Wedge design) 850mm wide x 400mm deep x 150mm high
Upright headstone	850mm wide x 400mm deep x 750mm high
Total Maximum height	750mm
